"Not all stains are created equal"

Type of Mark/ Stain?	Age of stain?	Material type?	Application details.	Conclusions.
Bic pen spill	Unknown	Cotton	Overnight soak	Multiple Applications

Additional comments: An ink spill such as this deposits a large amount of ink into a small area, this allows several layers of cloth and will require more than one application to break down the ink stain for removal. Apply: Soak Area, use absorbent cloth to mop up access. Leave: Overnight soaks will be required, Wash: A cold wash will start to remove the ink mark. Repeat as required.















This cotton shirt required 2 separate overnight soaks to remove the ink spill. The action of the pen in its designed "Dab, Dab, Dab" action helped breakdown the ink stain, with the addition of using an absorbent cloth used to soak up the access ink also reduced the required amount of pre soaks and wash cycles. This type of stain is moderate to hard to remove.
