"Not all stains are created equal"

Type of Mark/ Stain?	Age of stain?	Material type?	Application details.	Conclusions.
Dried Blood	Over 24 hours	Cotton	Direct application on hard surface	Multiple applications required.

Additional comments: Dried in blood is one of the most difficult stains to remove. Unless you apply the **MX14** solution quickly you will need to do multiple applications. **APPLY:** As soon as possible, place garment on hard surface and "Dab, Dab, Dab and Dab" this action will start the stain to break down, the area needs to be wet through to both sides and the entire area must be soaked. **LEAVE:** Patience is key with this type of stain, leave overnight as a minimal soak. Blood is organic and will be difficult to completely remove. **WASH:** If the garment will allow wash in a 60c or more wash, this will also help to breakdown the stain, use your normal washing powder. **If the stain is fading its working.** Repeat as required.

Patience is key. **APPLY:** Make sure the area is soaked and dabbed.

LEAVE: Overnight is a minimum.

WASH: If you can put in a 60c wash as this will help remove the stain.

If the stain is fading its working.

REPEAT AS REQUIRED.
